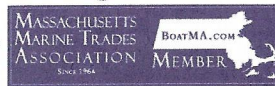


# Marine Technician

This 350-hour program is comprised of three courses that prepare students for a rewarding career in the recreational marine industry.

## Courses

### Fall Semester

#### Marine Technician Fundamentals (140 hrs)

Students will be provided with an overview of the marine industry and the multiple components of the marine technician working environment.

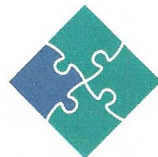
### Spring Semester

#### Marine Technician Outboard Engines (96 hrs)

Participants will learn the various parts and processes involved in the installation, repair, and maintenance of marine outboard engines.

#### Marine Technician Inboard Engines (114 hrs)

Participants will learn about the installation, maintenance and troubleshooting skills of inboard and diesel engines.
